CRESTDALE LANE & SUMMERLIN PARKWAY TRAIL PROGRESS UPDATE

The City appreciates Summerlin residents' patience with the closure of Crestdale Lane while crews construct a tunnel beneath Crestdale (see photo) to advance progress on the Summerlin Parkway Trail connection with nearby multi-use pathways.

Construction Progress to Date

Crestdale Lane will re-open by April 17, as City officials recognize how impactful the closure was on nearby residents and businesses as well as the importance of accommodating the popular 2026 Tour de Summerlin bike event.

While the road will be open to traffic, sidewalks will remain closed to ensure the safety of pedestrians as crews progress with the Summerlin Parkway Trail tunnel.



What's Next

Crews remain focused on constructing a multi-use pathway bridge that will cross the ravine behind The Resort at Summerlin (formally Rampart Casino), and adjacent to Summerlin Parkway. Current work includes utility and lighting installations.

The \$26 million project is scheduled to be completed in early 2027. The new 3.5-mile trail will provide a dedicated outdoor space for physical activity by offering a safe, aesthetically pleasing location for running, walking, and cycling. The trail will include new lighting, fencing, and trash receptacles.
